To: All creditors and investors of Wealth Pools International, Inc. and Recruit for Wealth, Inc.:

As you know, I am the court appointed Receiver for Wealth Pools International, Inc. and Recruit for Wealth, Inc. (collectively "Wealth Pools"). This letter represents the latest information regarding the activities of the Receiver as of July 30, 2008. Since my letter dated May 8, 2008, my staff has confirmed receipt of over *ten thousand (10,000)* claims that were postmarked on or prior to the May 30, 2008 bar date as set forth by the Court in the Order Establishing a Claims Procedure and Claims Bar Date (Dtk. No. 88) that was entered on March 20, 2008. My staff estimates that approximately *one hundred (158)* claims were received after the May 30, 2008 deadline.

Since the beginning of the claims process my staff has been completely dedicated to indexing and assembling the claims in anticipation of conducting a more comprehensive review of each claim and the supporting documentation that was provided. It has been noted that at least forty (40%) of the claims received are either missing documentation to support the claim or are missing information required in the actual claims form (including an original signature page). My staff has been and will continue to contact individuals either by email, voicemail or written correspondence for those without internet access to provide the claimants with an opportunity to supplement the claim form with the missing information.

Our next step in the process is to conduct a comprehensive review of the filed claims in conjunction with the books and records of WPI, to determine whether we believe the claims are valid or not. A process will be proposed to the court to handle claims objections and I will keep you updated through this website.


Unfortunately, despite our efforts at trying to locate and retrieve assets of Wealth Pools, at this point there is not much money or assets in the Wealth Pools estate – currently, there is approximately \$480,000, although we are anticipating a settlement which may add over two million dollars to the estate. In contrast, our preliminary review of the claims show that people are claiming that they are owed over \$66 million from Wealth Pools. You will see that any

distribution of assets will be pennies on the dollar based on this information. Any distribution of assets will not occur for many, many months, if at all.

Finally, if you have received an email confirmation from my staff that your claim has been received or, if you sent the claim via certified mail and have your signed receipt, you can be assured that we have your claim.
