ORDER

This cause comes before the Court for consideration of the following motions filed by Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC"):

1. Motion to Approve Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief Against Defendants Wealth Pools International, Inc. and Recruit for Wealth, Inc. and Final Judgment and Other Relief as to Relief Defendants Richard Lane and T-N-T- Education Company, Inc. (Doc. No. 172), filed on September 2, 2009; and
2. Motion to Approve Consent Judgment as to Defendant Robert Lane and Relief Defendants Renee Becker and Julia Lane (Doc. No. 174), filed on September 9, 2009.

The Court finds the motions to approve consent judgments as to Defendants Wealth Pools International, Inc., Recruit for Wealth, Inc., and Robert E. Lane and Relief Defendants Renee Becker and Julia Lane are due to be granted. However, before the Court will approve the consent judgments as to Relief Defendants Richard Lane and T-N-T- Education Company, Inc., the SEC shall re-draft the consent judgments so that the funds go directly to the Court-Appointed Receiver and not to the Registry of the Court. (*See* Doc. Nos. 172-5 p. 5; 172-4 pp. 4-5.) Specifically, the Court will not be responsible for any funds or payments. In the alternative, the SEC shall show cause as to why this cannot be done.

Based on the foregoing, it is ordered as follows:

1. Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Motion to Approve Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief Against Defendants Wealth Pools International, Inc. and Recruit for Wealth, Inc. and Final Judgment and Other Relief as to Relief Defendants Richard Lane and T-N-T- Education Company, Inc. (Doc. No. 172), filed on September 2, 2009, is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. The motion is GRANTED as to Defendants Wealth Pools International, Inc. and Recruit for Wealth, Inc. The motion is DENIED as to Relief Defendants Richard Lane and T-N-T Education Company, Inc. without prejudice and with leave to amend in compliance with the Court's directions.

2. Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission shall file Amended Consent Final Judgments as to Relief Defendants Richard Lane and T-N-T Education Company, Inc. by **SEPTEMBER 28, 2009**.


3. Relief Defendants Richard Lane and T-N-T Education Company, Inc. shall have until **OCTOBER 5, 2009** to file any objections to the Amended Consent Final Judgments.

4. Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Motion to Approve Consent Judgment as to Defendant Robert Lane and Relief Defendants Renee Becker and Julia Lane (Doc. No. 174), filed on September 9, 2009, is GRANTED.
