
Dear Investor:

As you know, I am the court appointed Receiver for Wealth Pools International, Inc. and Recruit for Wealth, Inc. (collectively "WPI"). As Receiver, I am charged with the task of, among other things, establishing a claims process. This letter is being sent to you in order to advise you of the most recent measures taken that relate to the claims procedure.

On February 29, 2008, I submitted a motion to the court requesting that a claims process be established so that investors and creditors may submit claims for outstanding sums owed to them by WPI. The motion also requested the Court to approve my *proposed* claim form which is attached to the motion as Exhibit "A" and set a date by which all claims must be submitted. The Court is expected to set a hearing soon to rule on the issues in my motion. Consequently, at this point we must await the Court's decision before the official claims process begins. **Please DO NOT submit your claim until you are notified to do so by my office. For any investor who prematurely downloaded the Claim Form attached to my motion and sent it to my office, please be advised that this claim will be rejected, and you will be required to resubmit the claim after the Court's ruling.**

In the meantime, I urge each of you to start assembling any records you have relating to WPI's indebtedness to you and to check the website regularly for new updates.
